

**CHANNEL DESIGN** — Map shows a small boat channel proposed for the Delaware River. It would begin at about point B, 7½ miles upstream from Easton, and extend south of Easton to point A, five miles south of the downtown area. Riffs would be constructed at points 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 so boats could operate under low stream flow conditions. A marina site would be constructed at the confluence of the Delaware and Lehigh rivers. The proposed improvements would interconnect five pools in the river by a channel 40 feet wide and four feet deep upstream from Old Sow Island.

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
